

CCC Covid-19 Protocols Summary

Updated: 8.09.21

The following applies to both our Celebration Campus and St. Cloud campus.

I. For All Weekend Worship Services

- People are encouraged to stay home if they are sick or showing any Covid symptoms
- Masks are optional when inside the chapel or any other venue
- Social distancing encouraged when possible
- Kids44 classes are mask-optional for children and for teachers
- Pursuit Student Ministry and adult classes are mask-optional
- Single-serve communion cups/wafers should continue to be used

II. For Ministry Gatherings, Events, and Meetings During Week

- People are encouraged to stay home if they are sick or showing any Covid symptoms
- Masks are optional
- Social distancing encouraged whenever possible

III. Scenarios for Possible Cases, Exposure, and Quarantine

- People are encouraged to stay home if they are sick or showing any Covid symptoms.
- We will no longer designate quarantine requirements for individuals, but leave it up to their discretion; however, for those individuals who have had a “close contact” direct exposure to a positive COVID case in any setting, even if no immediate symptoms are present, we would ask that you refrain from attending the next worship service and following weekday events.**

IV. Communication of Covid-19 Cases within CCC

- Public announcement is made in a fitting way (email, phone, text, verbal, etc.) to the CCC group(s) with which the individual had “close contact” from two days (48 hours) before the individual developed symptoms or tested positive.
